The Triton goal is to consistently breed Morgans with good size, sound legs and feet, athletic ability and beauty that have the special look of this unique breed. The Triton program has never lost sight of the fact that disposition is a key trait in the use and enjoyment of Morgan Horses.

Known for their show ring style and even temperament, the horses are a favorite of both the serious competitor and the casual rider. Therefore, it was to the delight and relief of many when the decision was made to continue the Triton breeding program after the recent passing of June Morgan, Triton Morgan Horse founder. The program will continue under the management of Bob Morgan, son of founders W. Robert and June Morgan.

Bob has been an active participant in the breeding program since its inception. He has witnessed some of the breed's greatest individuals, analyzing their conformation, and uses this background when planning breedings.

Assisting Bob is his wife, Susie Parks Morgan, a WC trainer, instructor and exhibitor. Together they bring more than 60 years of combined experience and share their knowledge by offering stallion service, sales, lessons and clinics.

Triton stallions include:

Masque N Black by Stonecroft Masquerade, was recently acquired and will stand for 2004. This impressive

black 2001 stallion will mature to over 16 hands and is highly tractable with impressive style and movement.

Futurity Robert M (Futurity's Noble Twist x AFF Obsession by Cedar Creek Harlequin), a young sire who proven himself with his first foal crop by siring the Morgan Medallion Regional Championships 1st place weanling filly and 2nd place weanling colt out of a crop of three.

Triton Wells Fargo (Don Dandy's Diamond x Triton Susan by Lippitt Pecos) continues the bloodline traditions started by W. Robert Morgan. The beautiful bay consistently throws his even temperament, correct movement, presence and beautiful conformation.

Fleetwing Lives, a full brother to Serenity Grandmaster, will continue to stand the 2004 season at Triton Morgans.

Good mares are just as important as good stallions when producing top horses. Bob and Susie have selected mares with top champion and champion-producing, strong bloodlines. The results are top quality foals.
